Tessa Volcheck, cellist, is the daughter of Mrs. Caryn Volcheck and Mr. John Volcheck. She started in the Centenary Suzuki School in 2013 and has studied cello with Mrs. Vaska-Haas 6 years. She will graduate from Caddo Magnet High School and will attend Louisiana State University, for a degree in biology, following a pre-med track. She received more than \$180,000 in scholarship from all universities she applied.



Here is a quote from Tessa: "I am going to miss many things after high school, but the one thing that I will miss most is the Suzuki program. I am a military kid and have moved many times, so I have never stayed somewhere long enough to put down roots and make a lot of friends. However, one thing that I have been able to carry with me is Suzuki. I have been with the Suzuki method since I was four and started cello at nine, and I have enjoyed it every minute. Music has gotten me through so much and there are not enough words to say how grateful I am for it. It taught me that no matter where I am in the world or life,
